The company reimburses 25 percent for most virtual summer camp costs and 50 percent for camps sponsored by <u>Noggin Builders</u>, a local business in nearby Northbrook that offers fun, hands-on learning activities for children ages 2 to 14.

The maximum benefit/subsidy is \$1,000 per employee for 2020 Virtual Summer Camp activities.
